TASTING NOTES

Made from Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz and Castelão grape varieties, this wine has a garnet colour with aromas of red fruits. In the mouth, it is smooth and rounded, with balanced acidity and ripe and elegant tannins.

THE REGION

The Geographical Indication (IG) Lisbon is one of the most important Portuguese wine regions, in terms of vineyard area and wine production. Formed by gentle hills, of low relief, IG Lisboa extends from the capital of Portugal to the north, always along the coast, in a range not exceeding 40 km wide. Multifaceted region encompasses several denominations of origin, ancient and modern, with distinct characteristics. The climate is temperate, of Atlantic influence, with relatively mild summer, cooler and wetter in the areas closer to the sea, warmer and drier in the areas protected by Montejunto mountain.

HISTORY

Ruelas was born to mirror the uniqueness of the Portuguese cobblestone sidewalk. In hornage to the craftsman masters, the art of their work is a staple image of Portugal, and their profession is one of the oldest of our national history. The production of these wines was done carefully, with time and a lot of passion.
